A Regular meeting of the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board was held in the boardroom of the Administration Centre, 235 Montée Lesage, Rosemère, QC on Wednesday, February 26, 2020 at 19:30 hours, at which were:

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- Á Objective 3: By 2030, have 85% of students under the age of 20 obtain a first diploma (SSD or DVS), and 90% obtain a first diploma or qualification this is the actual graduation rate, 84.5%, which is above the provincial average. The provincial average also includes private schools;
- A Objective 4: By 2030, increase to 90% the success rate on the composition component of the Elementary 6 (Cycle 3, Year 2) language of instruction ministerial examination in the public system. English Language Arts reports 93.6%.

The Director of Material Resources and Transportation continued the CTSP presentation noting that at this time the school board has completed improvement projects at Hillcrest Academy, Franklin Hill, Laurentian and Souvenir Elementary Schools; and Laval Junior Academy and Rosemere High School, which aligns with CTSP Objective 5: By 2030, ensure that all school buildings are in good condition.

The Director of Financial Resources advised that there was a \$105,000.00 surplus in 2018-2019 or less than 1% of the overall school board budget. The school board is currently updating its budgets more often as this assists the schools in monitoring spending.

The Director General noted that she is pleased with the annual report as the numbers, graduation and financial, are very good and that the dedicated and passionate employees of the school board are to be congratulated.

The Chairman thanked the Council of Commissioners for its commitment and dedication to the school board and that it should be very proud of these results.
